7 R E D E M P T I V E N A M E S O F J E H O V A H

Jehovah-Shammah

Translated “The Lord is there,” or present, revealing to us the redemptive privilege of enjoying His presence. He says, “Lo, I am with you always.” (Matthew 28:20).

EXAMPLES OF JEHOVAH-SHAMMAH IN SCRIPTURE:

“The distance all around will be 18,000 cubits. And the name of the city from that time on will be: the Lord is there.” (Ezekiel 48:35)

“Don’t you know that you yourselves are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in your midst?” (1 Corinthians 3:16)

“To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.” (Colossians 1:27)

7 REDEEMPTIVE NAMES OF JEHOVAH

Jehovah-Shalom

Translated “The Lord our Peace” and reveals to us the redemptive privilege of having His peace. Accordingly Jesus says, “My peace I give unto you.” (John 14:27)

EXAMPLES OF JEHOVAH-SHALOM IN SCRIPTURE:

“Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.” (1 Peter 5:7)

“Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.” (James 3:18)

“And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.” (Philippians 4:7)

7 R E D E M P T I V E N A M E S O F J E H O V A H

Jehovah-Ra-Ah

Translated “The Lord is my Shepherd.” He became our shepherd by giving “his life for the sheep.” (John 10:11) This revealed our redemptive privilege to be His sheep.

EXAMPLES OF JEHOVAH-RA-AH IN SCRIPTURE:

“The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall not want.” (Psalm 23)

“As for you, My sheep, the sheep of My pasture, you are men, and I am your God,”

declares the Lord GOD.” (Ezekiel 34:31)

7 REDEEMPTIVE NAMES OF JEHOVAH

Jehovah-Jireh

Translated “The Lord will Provide” an offering, and Christ was the offering provided for our complete redemption.

EXAMPLES OF JEHOVAH-JIREH IN SCRIPTURE:

“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.” (John 10:10)

“But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.” (Matthew 6:33)

“And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.” (Philippians 4:19)

7 REDEEMPTIVE NAMES OF JEHOVAH

Jehovah-Nissi

Translated to “The Lord is our Banner,” or “Victor,” or “Captain.” It was when, by the cross, Christ triumphed over principalities and powers that He provided for us, the redemptive privilege of saying, “thanks be to God, He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.” (1 Corinthians 15:27)

EXAMPLES OF JEHOVAH-NISSI IN SCRIPTURE:

“For everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.” (1 John 5:4)

“May we shout for joy over your victory and lift up our banners in the name of our God. May the LORD grant all your requests.” (Psalm 20:5)

“What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?” (Romans 8:31-32)

7 REDEEMPTIVE NAMES OF JEHOVAH

Jehovah-Tsidkenu

Translated “The Lord our Righteousness.” He becomes our righteousness by bearing our sins on the Cross. Receiving “the gift of righteousness” is our redemptive blessing.

EXAMPLES OF JEHOVAH-TSIDKENU IN SCRIPTURE:

“For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.” (Romans 10:4)

“For the Lord is righteous; he loves righteous deeds; the upright shall behold his face.” (Psalm 11:7)

“For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.” (2 Corinthians 5:21)

7 R E D E M P T I V E N A M E S O F J E H O V A H

Jehovah-Rapha

Translated “I am the Lord thy Physician,” or “I am the Lord that health thee.” This name is given to reveal to us the redemptive privilege of being healed as spoken of in Isaiah, “Surely he hath borne our sickness and carried our pains.” (Isaiah 53:4)

EXAMPLES OF JEHOVAH-RAPHA IN SCRIPTURE:

“For I am the Lord who heals you.” (Exodus 15:26)

“He heals the brokenhearted and bandages their wounds.” (Psalm 147:2)

“Such a prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make you well. And if you have committed any sins, you will be forgiven.” (James 5:15)
